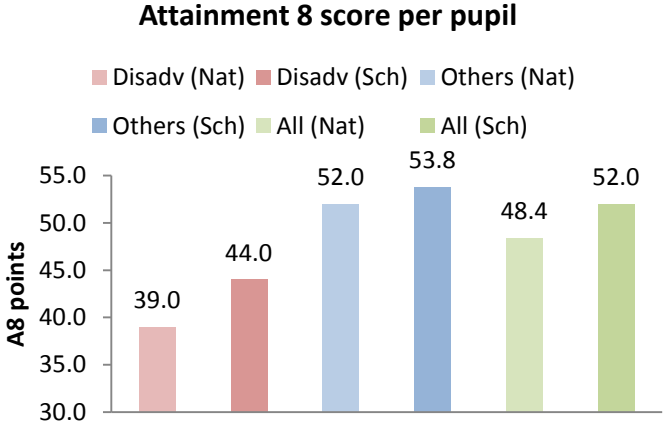


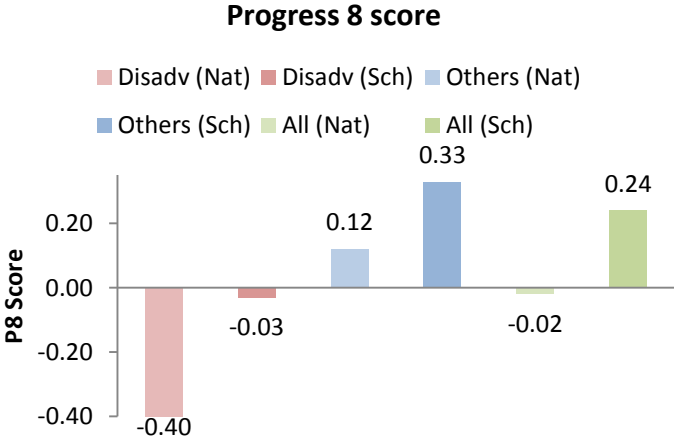
Pupil Premium: Additional funding is provided to the academy in the form of a pupil premium to help close the gap in attainment and progress between disadvantaged and others in in the school. Disadvantaged pupils are defined as those who have been eligible for free school meals in the last six years; or, Looked after continuously for 1 day or more; or, Adopted from Care. From a year group of 278 pupils in Year 11, 73 pupils had been categorised as entitled to pupil premium funding.

Attainment 8 (A8): Looking at the national picture (DfE, SRF 01/2016) for 2015, both disadvantaged and other pupils achieved above national A8 scores and the attainment gap is narrower compared to national. The average A8 score per disadvantaged pupil to be 39.0 compared to 52.0 for other pupils, an attainment gap of 13 points (1.3 grades). The schools figures are higher for both groups of pupils, at 54 points (disadvantaged) and 44 points (others) giving a 10 point (1 grade) attainment gap.

Progress 8 (P8): For P8, based on national figures for 2015 (DFE, SRF 01/2016) disadvantaged and other pupils made significantly more progress than their peers, with a smaller progress gap than national. Nationally, disadvantaged pupils have a score of -0.40, compared to other pupils’ score of 0.12, revealing a national P8 score gap of approximately half a grade. The school has scored +0.33 for other pupils compared to disadvantaged pupils of -0.03 revealing a P8 gap of slight above a third of a grade (+0.36).

EBacc: The EBacc was achieved by 16.4% of disadvantaged pupils compared to 29.3% of other pupils with 26% of all pupils achieving the Ebacc was at 26% (24% Nat 2015).

Destination Measures: The latest available data for destination measures shows the overall percentage of disadvantaged pupils going into sustained education or employment/training is 93% which is 8% higher than the national picture.

Value Added: The VA for disadvantaged pupils is 1007 compared to 976.3 (National 2015). The VA shows that on average, each disadvantaged pupil achieved the equivalent of one GCSE grade higher in one subject out of the best eight, than all pupils with similar prior attainment.
