Malet Lambert's Local Governing Body meet approximately 4 times per year, with additional opportunity for governors to monitor activity directly through school visits. Local governors play a key role in raising standards and monitoring performance with a core focus required on three strategic functions:-

- To ensure clarity of the school's vision, ethos and strategic direction.
- To hold the Headteacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils and the performance management of staff.
- To oversee the financial performance of the school and making sure its money is well spent.
