A Bitesize look at careers with the BBC

Year 9 and Year 10 had the opportunity to take part in a live careers event, hosted by BBC Bitesize in the main hall.

The event focused on jobs in media, IT and digital technology and STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Maths) industries.

Lasting an hour, the event was hosted by BBC RFL presenter Ross Fiddes and introduced pupils to jobs available in all kinds of tech

industries - from broadcasting and media production to flood defences and digital mood tracking.

Ross interviewed three local employees about the current work they do, plus the education journey they took to get there.

He was joined by Bobbi Hadgraft from BBC Radio Humberside, Jack Lonsdale from Stantec and Sam Wright from MoodBeam.

Pupils were able to ask questions via an interactive foam mic box which

was thrown out to the audience.

Pupils had some positive feedback about the event. Year 10 pupil Jayden said, "I enjoyed it, it was fun - I liked the interactive part of the session with the mic box that was thrown around so we could ask questions."

Eleanor had some constructive criticism too, she said, "It was interesting to hear the different jobs people have in the digital industry, though I would have liked to see some videos of them at work too."
