English pass rate soars under new GCSE system

Pupils and staff at Malet Lambert are celebrating positive GCSE results today, with a 62% pass rate in English and Maths at grade 9 - 4.

In the first year of the new GCSE grading scheme, five pupils have achieved the very highest grade of 9 in core subjects, with 34% achieving over grade 9 - 5.

Grade 5 is considered a 'strong' pass, equivalent to a high C/low B in the old grading system.

The new grades currently only apply to English Language, English Literature, and Maths. Other subjects are still marked A* - G for the time being.

Head of Year 11, and Acting Assistant Headteacher, Miss Pearson, has seen the hard work all pupils have put into their studies and couldn't be prouder.

She said, "Huge congratulations to all of our pupils on achieving such well-earned results from their relentless hard work and effort. We are very proud of their achievements."

Many subjects have seen excellent results, with English coming out as one of the top departments.


Four pupils scored grade 9 in English Language and Literature and the pass rate at grade 9 - 4 was an impressive 78%, with 63% of pupils achieving at least a grade 5.

Physical Education also saw wonderful results, with 76% of their pupils achieving grades A* - C.

Art and Textiles subjects had pass rates of over 70%.

Alongside our successful GCSE subjects, pupils taking our BTEC courses also secured top results.

Performing arts, music and engineering pupils achieved a 100% pass rate, and over 50% of Performing Arts pupils gained a Distinction*.
