Malet Lambert School Collective Worship Policy

Purpose

This policy provides a framework and guidance for staff to deliver the statutory requirement for collective worship.

The school will ensure that:

- There is a regular assembly for each House and for year groups to address age specific topics.
- The assemblies will follow a formal style to reinforce the traditional values of the school.
- The themes for the assemblies address moral, social, religious and cultural issues.
- There are a wide variety of outside speakers who talk to the pupils.

All teachers are expected to:

- Contribute to the whole school delivery of SMSC

Pupils will be encouraged to:

- Participate in discussion on topical issues in PSHE, registration time and in Enrichment days.

Arrangements for monitoring and evaluation:

- Members of the Senior Leadership Team deliver assemblies along with the Heads of Houses. Assemblies are observed by the Senior Leadership Team and feedback is given to the assembly leaders.
- Heads of House and Deputy Heads of Houses observe registration time and informally visit tutor groups during the term, giving feedback to the Deputy Headteacher.
