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I. Uniform Requirements

It is our expectation that all pupils will wear the correct school uniform as follows:

- Black blazer with school badge.
- White shirt with a collar and a house tie.
- Black, tailored trousers including small Malet based logo; must be free flowing and not tight fitting. (capri pants, jeans, cropped trousers, culottes, shorts, leggings and footless tights are not appropriate dress for school and are not permitted)
- Black, tailored skirt including small Malet based logo; must be knee length, free flowing and not tight fitting.
- Black shoes. Must be plain black including the soles with no additions such as tassels. Must also be flat with no heel. (trainers, combat style boots, converse, sand shoes and casual boots are not appropriate footwear for school and are not permitted)
- Pullovers are optional, must be black with school badge.
- No extreme hairstyles and hair should be a colour that may be naturally occurring in a significant majority of the child population.
- No facial or mouth piercings such as tongue piercings and no associated retainers. Pupils are only allowed to wear one set of small studded earrings.
- Pupils are permitted to wear discreet make-up. False eyelashes are not permitted.
- Nails must be natural; we will not accept false nails of any description.

Outside clothing must be removed upon entry to the school building.

Any pupil whose uniform is not compliant must have a specific, reasonably valid and dated note from home from the past two weeks, to reduce the chance of a sanction which is most likely to include the removal of social time but may also result in guided learning away from normal classes.

2. Purchasing Uniforms

The school wear supplier, which supplies everything in one place for parental convenience, is Steady Schoolwear. We respect the need for parental choice in where they purchase garments which is why skirts and trousers can already be purchased from anywhere so long as they meet the school requirements and then brought in for the school logo to be applied free of charge once the school has approved the items. 3. Logo

Skirts and trousers purchased from the uniform shop will automatically have the logo attached.

Skirts and trousers purchased from any other retailer need to be approved by the school and we will then arrange for the logo to be attached at no cost to you. We must see the child wearing the garments in order to approve them. Until the point that garments have been approved please retain all receipts.

We offer an extensive number of dates when children, accompanied by parents if you prefer, can get trousers and skirts approved. We send regular updates to parents of these dates.
