For now, the following pages give you clear details of how education providers are currently handling applications and places. The overwhelming message is that providers are honouring all places that have currently been offered.

Not yet applied?

If pupils have not yet applied for any courses, they should do so as soon as they can. They can either apply direct on a college/training providers' website, or use www.logonmoveon.co.uk to search for courses and make lots of applications in one go. Pupils should have their login details, but if they have forgotten, you can email me for a password reset.

Further queries.

Although the majority of college staff are working from home, they are still answering queries from pupils. We have included email addresses for all establishments. There are also many updates via social media, so we recommend following them on Facebook and Twitter where you can find up-to-date information.

BISHOP BURTON COLLEGE

Virtual Open Event 22nd April 5-8pm - Our open event which was planned for Wednesday 22nd April 5-8pm will still take place. As we are unable to see students on campus face to face, our event will now take place online. Our virtual open event website will offer all the information that you expect to receive at an Open Event, and we will have academic and student services staff on hand to answer any questions via our new live chat function. 1) Bishop Burton College - We are still accepting applications!

Our entry requirements will in essence remain the same, however, we will be flexible in our approach and allow some movement of students between course levels during the first 6 weeks based on our own initial assessments. Given recent developments, we will assess every student application on individual merit and circumstances, and we will seek to ensure no student is disadvantaged because of the extraordinary circumstances we find ourselves in.

We are still accepting new applications and conducting interviews over the telephone.

2) Bishop Burton College: if a student has already accepted a Conditional offer.

We want to reassure your students that we are honouring any offers that have been made.

Entry requirements for this September remain at Grade 4-9's in 4 GCSE's including Maths English & Science. Students can apply via www.heta.co.uk or via LogOnMoveOn.
