If a pupil hasn't received an invite (apologies if this is the case), or has left a classroom by mistake, they need to use the following codes to join the relevant classrooms:

Any late submissions of key pieces for marking can still be marked by your teachers, and feedback given. It is important for all pupils to catch up with any work they have missed where possible.
