Y9 GCSE History: Thursday 2nd July - 10am - 12pm and 5pm - 6pm (particularly aimed at Y9 pupils who have been in school for the day)

The Live Chats will be hosted by members of the History Team (Miss Cutts, Mrs Knight, Miss Norman, Miss Ridley & Miss Binns) - we will post an announcement on the stream on Monday 29th June to let you know who will be available for each of the sessions.
