Visiting School - Reminder

It is vital that we limit the number of visitors into the school reception. Only crucially important meetings will take place and parents/carers can only come into the school if they have a pre-arranged appointment.

It is therefore very important that you discuss with your child the importance of them not forgetting items at home. Such items are PE kits, homework and lunch. Where a pupil does forget their lunch we will call home and ask that you put money onto your ParentPay account and they will have to purchase a school lunch.

Lateral Flow Testing

Please continue with Lateral Flow testing, we recommend Sunday and Wednesday evening's, however please feel free to test in line with your families own testing schedule. Please also continue to register your child's results in these 2 places:

Facial Coverings

All pupils must wear a face covering during the designated times/areas. Please ensure your child has a spare with them.

Rapid Lateral Flow Testing Kits for Families with Early Years, School and College Age Children

Free Covid-19 home testing kits are available to all families and households with early years, primary, secondary school and college-aged children and young people, including childcare and support bubbles, as well as adults working in the school community.

Families are encouraged to test themselves at home twice-weekly in order to identify Covid-19 cases quickly and break the chain of transmission. Tests are either delivered to your home or you can collect them from a local testing site. You do not need an appointment.
