Collecting Pupils from School

Anyone collecting a child from school must have ID with them. If they do not, this may delay the child leaving school and could make them late for an appointment, however the safeguarding of pupils is of the utmost importance.

ParentPay Alerts

You may already be aware that there are numerous alerts that can be set up in your ParentPay account, one of which is to let you know when your child's lunch account is running low.

To do this:

- Log into your account
- Select Communication, Alert Settings
- Scroll down to Balance Alerts
- In the threshold box add the amount you require, we recommend no less than the cost of a meal deal (£2.20)
- Tick Email (or Text, however there is an addition cost to ParentPay for this)
- Scroll to the bottom of the screen and click Save

Visiting School - Reminder

It is vital that we limit the number of visitors into the school reception. Only crucially important meetings will take place and parents and carers can only come into the school if they have a pre-arranged appointment.

Where a pupil does forget their lunch we will call home and ask that you put money onto your ParentPay account and they will have to purchase a school lunch.
