Charging and Remissions Policy – Library Book Fees

Recent amendments have been made to our Charging and Remissions Policy with regard to the non-return of library books, which are currently charged at a flat fee of £3.00.

The school will replace the outstanding item at the lowest cost; this amount will then be added to the Parent/Carer's ParentPay account. This new payment structure will take effect from 1st June 2021.

If you have any items outstanding, please arrange to pay £3.00, via ParentPay, before 1st June 2021. Items remaining outstanding after 1st June will be re-costed, using the new structure, and Parents/Carers will be informed of the amount due, in lieu of the item being returned.

How does your child travel to Malet Lambert

As part of the planned extension to Malet Lambert later in the year to allow for increased pupil numbers. The school is required to have a School Travel Plan in place and to review it on an annual basis

A School Travel Plan is a document that:

- Demonstrates a schools commitment to environmental and community concerns and the overall welfare of its pupils
- States the way in which a school intends to help reduce the use of cars for the school journey, and for improving safety, the environment, health and the social skills of its pupils
- Is a whole school initiative and demonstrates support from pupil, staff, parents, governors and the wider community.
- Aims to give parents and pupils the choice of traveling by walking, cycling and public transport with confidence thereby reducing congestion at the school gate.

- Looks in detail at pupil's needs on the school journey and attempts to find suitable solutions for unique situations at each school.
- Has clearly stated aims, objectives and targets which are achievable, measurable and are supported by the whole school community
- School Travel Plans also play a key role in Safer Routes to School projects and act as guides for possible transport and highway infrastructure improvements

The school travel plan will be assessed by Hull City Council highways agency as part of the planning process for our school expansion.
