Uniform Logo Session

Malet Lambert has worked closely with our uniform provider Steady School Wear, to give parents and carers the opportunity to buy our school uniform directly from them, but in order to make uniform more affordable parents and carers also have the choice to purchase uniform from other retail outlets and then have the uniform checked by Malet Lambert colleagues who then arrange for the uniform to have the logo printed on to the specific garments (Skirts & Trousers)

Our next logo session for all year groups will be held on:
Wednesday 1st December 2021 - in the forum at 3:10pm.

Ready for the date, we would ask that parents and carers familiarise themselves once again with the uniform policy in order that the skirts/trousers comply with the policy.

NOTE: Pupils will need a change of clothing if they are requiring a logo on the garment, they are wearing that day. Pupils can have their items checked and then left with us ready for collection from Student Services the following morning.

As we move forward our aim is to offer a logo printing session every 3 weeks in order that newly purchased items can be printed with the logo.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank our parents and carers who have supported the school and sent their child/children back to school in full uniform which complies with our School Uniform Policy and to let you know that if there is any concern or issue with obtaining uniform then please speak to your child's specific House Team.

COVID-19

As per the letter that was emailed out to all parents yesterday from the local public health team (see attached) [COVID-19 Measures Update, 25.11.21](#) Malet Lambert has seen a steady increase of COVID-19 cases in school. Due to this, the school will have a mobile PCR testing unit on the school site next Monday and Tuesday, with the intention of testing year 8 and 10 in the first instance on Monday. Pupils will only be tested where consent has previously been given.

If you wish to withdraw your consent or have now decided to give consent please contact enquiries@maletlambert.hull.sch.uk. At this stage we are not currently planning on testing other year groups, but again if you wish to remove or add consent please use the same email address. Please note if a pupil has had COVID-19 within the last 90 days, there is no need for them to have PCR as it is likely that this could still show as a positive result.

The school has provided on Friday over 1200 fabric, hard wearing face coverings. They were given to year 8, 10 & 11 at the gate when entering the school and then to year 7 & 9 in the afternoon. We are strongly recommending

that all pupils (unless exempt) continue to wear a face covering in communal areas. This again will help reduce the spread of COVID-19.

We would continue to ask all pupils to test a minimum of twice weekly at home, preferably on a Wednesday and a Sunday. LFT test kits are available from the Admin Office, Student Services and all House Offices.

We would like to thank you all for your patience and support as we continue to work together to keep pupils in school.

Year 7 and Year 8 - Accelerated Reader

Developing reading ability, and reading for pleasure, is one of our key focuses at Malet Lambert. Reading for pleasure not only benefits students academically - increasing their reading and writing abilities - it also allows them to enhance their general knowledge, gain a better understanding of other cultures, and gives them a greater insight into human nature.

One of the ways in which we aim to support students' reading abilities and encourage to read for pleasure is through the introduction of the Accelerated Reader computer program. This computer program - explained in detail in the attached leaflet - allows teachers to monitor students' independent reading, give support with reading where it is needed, and track the development and progression of students' reading ability over time; students can use the school-based computer program to take quizzes on books that they have read and the results of these quizzes allow them to see how they are developing as readers. In addition, the program also helps students to choose books which will be appropriate for them and is able to make recommendations to the students based on the books that they have completed reading.

How can parents support reading for pleasure?

One of the best ways to support reading for pleasure is to encourage your child to spend at least twenty minutes a day reading for pleasure. Regular and consistent short bursts of twenty minutes focused reading have been proven to help children to develop their reading abilities over time.




Exams in 2022
