PCR Testing

LFT Testing

We have planned a further session of Lateral Flow Testing on **Tuesday 4th January** (the day before pupils return to school after the Christmas break). **This is for all pupils where consent has been given and have not had COVID-19 within the last 90 days.**

PE – Outdoor Lessons / Winter Clothing

As we come to the winter months and with temperatures dropping, the PE Department would like to take the opportunity to remind pupils to ensure that they bring suitable clothing for their outdoor PE lessons.

Year 11 Post-16

Pupils should be in the process of completing applications for further education or training at the moment. We have been giving pupils time and support to complete their applications via Log On Move On (LOMO) in PSHE lessons this term, and hope to run a catch up session in January. In the meantime, pupils are welcome to complete their applications independently at home, as many have done so already. Pupils should apply for **at least two providers** to ensure they have a preferred option and a back-up plan.
