## PE lessons

## Pupils unable to take part in a PE lesson due to injury or illness

If your child is unable to take part in a PE lesson due to injury or illness please email attendance@maletlambert.hull.sch.uk explaining the reason why your child is unable to participate practically and an estimated date they will return to practical PE. If a pupil is not taking part in the practical part of the lesson they will still require their PE kit as they will be undertaking a different role in the lesson e.g. referee, coach, analyst etc. So, all pupils need PE kit for ALL lessons.

## PE Kit & Equipment

If your child is unable to wear the full Malet Lambert PE kit for a one-off lesson please always send them with a suitable replacement. The PE Department would much prefer your child to take part in PE in a different kit rather than miss the practical element of the lesson due to not having Malet PE kit.

During cold weather pupils are advised to wear warm clothes under their Malet Lambert PE t-shirt. There is also a Malet ½ zip top available from the school's supplier. We also advise all pupils to bring a drink to their PE lessons to help them remain. hydrated, around the school we provide a lot of water fountains so pupils just need to bring a refillable bottle.

# Year 11 - Post-16 Applications and Open Events

Year 11 pupils will be supported in school over the next year with applying for their next step. In their first lesson of PSHE they are creating an account on Log On Move On, a common application process which allows pupils to apply for multiple opportunities at various providers from one account. It is run by East Riding Council and is a wonderful, time-saving tool for pupils, and allows staff to monitor applications and support where necessary. If pupils do not have their logins, they can get in touch with me. They should continue to use this tool outside of lessons.

Local colleges and training providers will be attending school to give talks about their establishment in **Year 11 assemblies** over the next half term. Pupils will be provided with further information of available opportunities in tutor time and can access the **Year 11 CEIAG Google Classroom**, where key information and links will be posted.

Year 11 pupils will also start to have **careers interviews** with qualified advisors from next week. Some pupils will be put forward by tutors and heads of house for extra support, but ALL pupils have the option to have an interview if they would like one. They can access the self-referral form on the Google Classroom, or they can ask their tutor to email a request to Miss Powell.
