## **SAFEGUARDING CORNER**

### **Child Sexual Exploitation**

Often referred to as CSE for short

The NSPCC recently published a child sexual abuse statistics briefing which suggested that around 1 in 20 children in the UK have been sexually abused. This is a disturbing and highly

upsetting statistic but our approach in safeguarding corner is to be open and honest about the possibilities around our young people.

CSE is a type of sexual abuse. When a child or young person is exploited they're given things, like gifts, drugs, money, status and affection, in exchange for performing sexual activities. Children and young people are often tricked into believing they're in a loving and consensual relationship. This is called grooming and can happen to any child irrespective of background, circumstance, age or interest.

They may trust their abuser and not understand that they're being abused. CSE can often start on-line and may then develop to in person exchanges but grooming can happen in so many different ways.

As a school we cover CSE in a variety of ways through assemblies and our PSHE curriculum which focuses on healthy relationships in the hope that our pupils know when they are in an unhealthy one.

But we know that you as parents have the biggest impact and influence on your children - and those vital discussions that we know you have with them
