# Report Concerns To Us - Promptly, Factually And In The Way That Works Best For You

In every school, parents will rightly on the rare occasion raise safeguarding concerns about their child in respect of behaviours inside and outside of school

We welcome being told and we want to help

Please support us, your child and the process by reporting matters

### **Promptly**

We know just how busy you all are but the best time for us to gather information is when it is all still "fresh" in the minds of all concerned. We all know how challenging it can be to remember back to something that happened just a few days earlier. So always report but aim to report promptly please

### Factually

If your child comes home with a worrying account then you have every right to share those worries. Clearly you will listen carefully to your child but please try to then re-visit their account and consider bullet pointing some of the key facts. By asking some follow up questions it can help the investigation process that the school will follow when you get in touch

### In A Way That Works Best For You

We know just how busy you all are and that you will want or need to use a different way of sharing concerns but some ways will be more effective than others

### Please consider:

- Using the PAWS "app" at certain times
- Make use of the pupil planner to communicate requests for call backs
- Email enquiries with a short summary of the issue and clear guidance on the best way and time to contact you back
- Book a face to face appointment but to avoid disappointment or frustration always avoid simply turning up to school without a pre-arranged appointment
