### Personal Development Update

Pupils after Christmas will turn their attention back to the Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) element of their Personal Development curriculum, through their weekly PSHE lessons. Our spiral PSHE curriculum model means that pupils will return to the theme of RSE during each of their five years at Malet Lambert, looking at different and age-appropriate content each time they engage with this topic.

Over the first half of the spring term, pupils in Year 7, 8 and 9 will deal with some lesson content that will be of a sensitive nature. At appropriate points in many of these lessons, we take the opportunity to remind pupils of important laws related to relationships, sex and the treatment of others.

### PE Lessons

If your child is unable to take part in a PE lesson due to injury or illness please email attendance@maletlambert.hull.sch.uk explaining the reason why your child is unable to participate practically and an estimated date they will return to practical PE. If a pupil is not taking part in the practical part of the lesson they will still require their PE kit as they will be undertaking a different role in the lesson e.g. referee, coach, analyst etc. <u>So, all pupils need PE kit for ALL lessons</u>.

## <u>PE Kit & Equipment</u>

If your child is unable to wear the full Malet Lambert PE kit for a one-off lesson please always send them with a suitable replacement. The PE Department would much prefer your child to take part in PE in a different kit rather than miss the practical element of the lesson due to not having Malet PE kit. During cold weather pupils are advised to wear warm clothes under their Malet Lambert PE t-shirt. There is also a Malet  $\frac{1}{4}$  zip top available from the school's supplier. We also advise all pupils to bring a drink to their PE lessons to help them remain hydrated. Around the school we do provide a lot of water fountains so pupils just need to bring a refillable bottle.

## Wishing you a Safe and Merry Christmas from the Safeguarding corner!

The following guidance has been taken from the Gov.UK website to enable us all to have a happy and safe Christmas:

- Check your Christmas tree lights carry the British Safety Standard sign
- Never place candles near your Christmas tree or materials that can catch light easily
- Test your smoke alarms at least monthly and only remove batteries when replacing them
- Most fires start in the kitchen. Avoid leaving a cooker unattended
- Avoid cooking when under the influence of alcohol
- ❖ Make sure your family and visitors know how to escape in an emergency
- ❖ Make sure cigarettes are put out properly
- Decorations can burn easily so don't attach them to lights or heaters
- \* Keep candles, lighters and matches out of children's reach. Never leave burning candles unattended
- Never overload electrical sockets. Always switch Christmas lights off and unplug them before you go to hed
- Store fireworks safely. Never go back to a lit firework and keep a bucket of water nearby
- Take care around open fireplaces as clothes may catch fire
