YEAR 11 INFORMATION

Year 11 Celebration Event

This is just a reminder of the following information, which is emailed out to parents every 2 weeks so they can track their child's progress towards the event.

As you will be aware, Malet Lambert traditionally hosts a Year 11 Celebration Event to mark the end of our pupils' journey with us. The celebration evening will be on the 27th June 2024, further details to be confirmed.

Pupils will be invited to attend the Celebration Event if they meet specified criteria. These criteria are designed to help accelerate the progress of our pupils and to ensure that they are providing themselves with an opportunity to meet their potential.

The criteria for the prom is an average of:

- No more than 4 behaviour points per week
- No more than 1 unauthorised absence per fortnight

No external suspensions

Their criteria started on the 3rd July 2023, the eligibility period will run for 36 weeks.

For the remainder of the academic year, we will provide regular updates on this data so parents and carers can make informed decisions on purchasing clothing etc. The information you will be provided with is to ensure that you and your child are fully aware of their eligibility. If they do not meet the criteria at any point, please do make the time to discuss areas for improvement.

SAFEGUARDING CORNER

This week in safeguarding corner we are focusing on our PSHE (Personal, Social Health and Economic) lessons. Safeguarding is all about equipping our children to know when situations are unsafe so that they can avoid them and/or know the best course of action if they do find themselves within them. Every week our children follow a set of well-planned PSHE lesson ranging from topics such as Healthy Relationships to Budgeting and Exploitation to Careers. Lessons work in a spiral so that a Year 7 pupil studies a set of topics that are then re-visited but expanded upon in Year 8 and so on. This is how we ensure that our curriculum stays age-appropriate for all. Written work is clearly a part of our PSHE lessons but the opportunity for discussion and debate are just as important as pupils are provided with a safe place to explore misconceptions and check their understanding. We assess a variety of skills that will be essential in life outside and after school, such as the evaluation of misinformation.
