By following the ORANGE pathway, your child will follow the core curriculum including:

- GCSE English Language and GCSE English Literature
- GCSE Mathematics
- GCSE Combined Science Trilogy
- Core PE and PSHE

In addition, pupils will be able to continue with their literacy and numeracy interventions as well as following our Inspire curriculum which is delivered by the Tigers Trust.

Pupils can then select two additional options from the list and then one reserve option.

When selecting their options, it is vital pupils are aware of key details such as what content is covered by the course, how is the course assessed and will this course support me with my future plans.

### Inspire Curriculum

Students at Malet Lambert accessing the Inspires provision have consistency over the full year working with the same member of Tigers Trust staff and complete short courses with ASDAN gaining certification upon completion. They cover modules including enterprise, careers and experiencing work and PSHE. In addition, pupils also cover uncertified activities such as social skills and managing money to overall better prepare them for college and the working world. By following the Inspire curriculum, we believe pupils can develop skills and participate in activities which is difficult to provide in other areas of the curriculum.

During our recent Ofsted inspection, they stated:

“The curriculum is adapted through the Inspires provision for a small cohort of pupils. This bespoke curriculum delivered in partnership through the Tigers Trust enables pupils to learn vital life skills, careers education and employability experiences. The Inspire curriculum has a clear plan, sequence and enables pupils to study a good quality suite of qualifications. This is impactful in terms of pupils core subjects but also supports them with the smooth transition to the next stage of their education of training.”
