This week the Government's guidance on mobile phone "bans" has been back in the news. Parents will recall that many years ago Malet Lambert took its own steps to "ban" the sight and/or use of phones during the school day. Many years on, we have seen many positives for our pupils in respect of their safeguarding and well-being

- More positive verbal communication between our pupils at social times
- A significant increase in positive mental health through pupils being away from screens for at least 7 hours per day.
- Parental choice respected by pupils being able to have their phone on them when travelling to and from school
- Pupils being able to more fully focus on learning as they switch off from a perceived need to check mobile phone updates.

We look forward to continuing our positive partnership with parents and please continue to remind them that so long as their phones are switched off and away then they will always be able to retain it
