Generic Full School Information

Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE)

Personal, Social, Health and Economic education equips pupils with the knowledge, understanding, skills and strategies required to live healthy, safe, productive, capable, responsible and balanced lives. It encourages them to be enterprising and supports them in making effective transitions, positive learning and career choices and in achieving economic wellbeing. At Malet Lambert, the PSHE Curriculum is delivered through six Enrichment Days throughout the school year. During these days, pupils will follow a timetable which allows them the opportunity to participate in lessons, workshops, talks and activities which support the PSHE themes.

On all but one of the days the Year 7 – 10 pupils remain in their tutor groups so they can be guided and supported by their Form Tutor; this also continues to build on the family ethos of each tutor group within the Malet Lambert House system. Attendance on Enrichment Days is crucial in order that each pupil benefits from the knowledge and skills gained during the delivery of the PSHE curriculum.

During the next Enrichment Day, pupils in Year 7 -10 will complete a unit of work on the following topics:

Year Group	Topic
7	Celebrating Differences: Includes a presentation from Hull City Council Waste Management Services
8	Healthy Relationships: Also includes a presentation from Hull University “Steps to Success” team
9	Justice, Human Rights and Equality: Also includes a presentation from Paul Spense, representing his charity P.A.U.L for Brain Recovery
10	Relationships and Sex Education: Also includes a presentation from Paul Spense, representing his charity P.A.U.L for Brain Recovery
11	GCSE Subject Focus & Study Skills

For Year 11, Enrichment Days are also essential for intervention work in specific examined subjects, ensuring the completion of vocational qualifications, and effective study skills and revision in preparation for the forthcoming summer examination series. The next Enrichment Day will see Year 11 pupils completing work and revision towards either their Sports Studies or ICT qualification. Attendance on Enrichment Days for Year 11 pupils studying these vocational qualifications is critical, Sports Studies pupils will be completing controlled assessment that equates to 50% of their final mark and ICT pupils will be revising for their final examination in the subject of which they will sit in February.
