### Generic Full School Information

#### **Tutor Period and Behaviour Detentions**

Starting the first week back after half term:

- Any pupil that does not go to Tutor Time will receive a 20 minute detention after school the following day, to be completed in the main hall.
- Deputy Heads of House will collect pupils and escort them to the detention.
- Any pupil who thinks they should have received their mark (for whatever reason) should still attend the detention. The Head of House will investigate.
- It will be the pupils' responsibility to ensure they get their mark.
- If a pupil refuses or fails the detention, they will be placed in isolation the following morning 8.45am - 11am, missing their break time.
- Whilst in isolation, if the pupil does not fully comply with the rules and working practises, they will be kept in isolation until they do comply, potentially until 3.45pm.

#### **Detentions for Behaviour Incidents**

Starting the first week back after half term.

- Year 7-10 will carry on as they are now. If they fail to attend their lunchtime behaviour detention they are to be taken to isolation, period 4 and 5 until 3.45pm.
- Year 11 will be placed in isolation the next morning until 11am, missing their break time. If they do not comply they will stay in isolation until they do, potentially until 3.45pm.

#### **Uniform Logo Session**

The next uniform Logo Session will be held on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> March 2020 from 4.30pm until 6.30pm. Future Logo Sessions have been updated on the 'Dates for your Diary' below.

#### **Reminder - Uniform after Half Term**

Whilst the vast majority of pupils continue to comply with all aspects of our uniform policy, we recognise that a very small minority need additional support to meet our expectations. To that end, after half term we will be operating a very simple system, which will focus upon footwear in the first instance. In short, where a pupil is wearing trainers (or other non-compliant footwear) they will be loaned a pair of plain black, newly purchased shoes in the correct size for the full day. To support, further we will securely store their trainers and give them back at the end of the day when the pupil returns the loaned footwear. For clarity, in the unlikely event that a pupil refuses the loan of newly purchased shoes, which comply with our uniform policy, we will initially arrange for a pupil to be out of circulation during social times. Ultimately, we want to work together with all parents to ensure that all pupils comply with our expectations around uniform. If your child has a medical condition that dictates their footwear please ensure that your child carries with them an up to date note from yourself with a best contact number that you be called on to discuss the matter as need be. As we move forward, we will apply the same systems to other aspects of our uniform. We appreciate all of your ongoing support in this matter.

#### **Reminder - Hair Colouring**

In response to pupil and parental feedback, we are further clarifying our school expectations around hair colouring. As we have widely publicised for many years, pupils' hair must be of a colour, which is naturally occurring in the child population. To that end, red hair dyes amongst others are not allowed. For total clarity, nor do we accept any other modifications or additions which change hair colour using anything that could not be immediately and instantly removed upon request. So for example, hair braids are totally acceptable so long as they are of a naturally occurring colour such as black. Hair braids are of course available in colours such as vibrant red but these are not allowed at Malet Lambert.

We will be adhering very strictly to the above policy from Monday 24<sup>th</sup> February. We feel this provides ample opportunity for any outstanding issues or misunderstandings to be addressed. Beyond this date, the simple and consistent sanction for

any pupils not meeting this expectation will be supervised social time away from their peers until the hair meets our expectations as outlined above. In as school with 1550 pupils, it vital that we send out simple, clear and consistent messages to our pupils.
