Generic Full School Information

Collection of a child during the school day

We are sure you will agree, the safeguarding of our pupils is one of our top priorities. With this in mind, when collecting your child from school, during the school day, for example for a doctor's appointment etc., you must bring ID with you. If you are arranging for someone else to collect your child they must also bring ID, but also be a named contact on your child's record. It is the parent/carers responsibility to keep your child's emergency contacts up to date. If someone arrives to collect your child and they are not a named contact on our system, we will not allow them to leave school without speaking to you. If you do not do this in advance of the appointment, this could result in you being late for the appointment; however, our priority is ensuring that no pupil leaves school without the parent/carers prior knowledge.

You must also call the Attendance Team on 374211 and choose option 1. They will then make a note on your child's record so that teachers know what time they need to leave, this should reduce the amount of time you need to wait for them.

Pupil Guidance

Whilst there are concerns on the news about health it is important to remember that some of the most effective ways of avoiding becoming unwell are also the simplest. There are general principles we should all follow to help us stay healthy:

- wash hands often with soap and water, using our new toilet facilities. You may also use hand sanitiser if handwashing facilities are not available. This is particularly important if you use a school bus.
- wash your hands:
 - on arrival at school
 - after using the toilet
 - before and after breaks and sporting activities
 - before food preparation
 - before eating any food, including snacks
 - when you get home
 - for as long as it takes to sing Happy Birthday twice
- cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in a bin. Ask your teacher for a tissue if you need one.
- avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- avoid close contact with friends if they are unwell.
- if your parents/carers are worried about your symptoms or those of anyone else in your family, please call NHS 111.
